



Project outcomes

Training course materials and tools for asylum seekers, refugees, and their family members:

- Language course curriculum and training modules;
- Language courses and inducted civic and intercultural skills sessions;
- Tools to uncover and subsequently enhance vital competences and skills (screening, profiling and preparing);
- Pocket book with assistive materials on entering and improving their relevance to the local labour market.

Tools for trainers:

- Train-the-trainer handbooks and short "How to" guides to support the provision of the integration activities;
- Sets of detailed case studies that demonstrate the impact and combat stereotypes towards immigrant and refugee communities;

The above achievements contribute to the fast track integration of asylum seekers, refugees, and their family members.
